



ORDER OF BRITISH COLUMBIA

NOMINATION FORM

The Order of British Columbia was established by statute on April 21, 1989 to recognize those persons who have served with the greatest distinction and excelled in any field of endeavour benefiting the people of the Province or elsewhere.

Fields of endeavour may consist, for example, of community leadership; business; labour; industry; volunteer service; the professions and other occupations; research; culture; the arts; sports, and others.

Federal, provincial and municipal elected representatives are not eligible for appointment to the Order while they remain in office.

A person may not be appointed to the Order posthumously unless the Advisory Council recommends the appointment to the Lieutenant-Governor in Council before the person's death.

Any person or organization may nominate a resident of British Columbia or former long-term resident.
